Millred was the first born to Lewis Cornelius Farmer b. in Texas and Iva Alma Johnson Farmer b. in Nebraska. Millred is buried in Riverside Cemetery Sec. 50 Lot 14 Block 12. Lewis (20) and Iva (16) were married in Wyoming in 1909, moving to Colorado shortly after to be close to Iva's older sister Cora Johnson Hamm. After little Millred's death Lewis and Iva moved to Oregon. Iva had more family there for support. Lewis worked as a car inspector for the railroad, until he was injured and was put on disability. Iva was a homemaker, great cook and flower gardener. Lewis and Iva had two more children, Edna I in 1913 and Delmont E. in 1917. Lewis drowned in 1938 at the age of 51. Iva lived in Oregon the remainder of her life and died at age 88." Picture is of Millred' parents and sister Edna.
